



### Ottawa

OTTAWA is the capital of Canada, located 200 km to the West of Montreal and 450 Km to the East of Toronto.

- OTTAWA is a safe city, with many museums, parks, two rivers and the Rideau canal, which is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- The <u>University of Ottawa</u> is located downtown, where there are many hotels, restaurants and several touristic sites can be reached by foot (Parliament Hill, Rideau canal, Byward Market, art galleries, museums, etc)
- The Ottawa International Airport in normal times has direct flights to Toronto, Montreal, Vancouver, Washington DC, Newark, Chicago, London-Heathrow, Frankfurt, and others.
- The government of Canada and local health authorities are considered trustworthy at a time of world pandemics.





If it ends up begin not safe to run the conference on-site we will be prepared to run it online.






### The conference room (capacity ±120 people);

Its flexible layout allows for setup with physical distancing







### uOttawa and STEM building are steps from the Rideau Canal












## RIDEAU CANAL: locks leading to the Ottawa River




